THE HEALTH SERVICE (PHARMACEUTICAL) (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT)  
(GUERNSEY) REGULATIONS, 1974

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (2) of section five of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of First Schedule to the principal regulations

1. Part I of the First Schedule to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1972 (hereafter in these regulations referred to as "the principal regulations"), is hereby repealed and Part I set out in the Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Saving

2. Notwithstanding the repeal of Part I of the First Schedule to the principal regulations by regulation one of these regulations, a medical prescription or a copy thereof in the form set out in that Part of that Schedule shall continue to be treated for the purposes of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, and of any regulations made thereunder, as if it were a medical prescription within the meaning of that Law and of those regulations.

Citation, collective title and commencement

3.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1974.

(2) These regulations, the principal regulations and the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (General) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973, may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1972 to 1974.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the *twenty third* day of *July*, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These regulations amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1972, by prescribing a revised form of prescription order to be used by medical practitioners and dentists ordering the supply of drugs and medicines under the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972. Prescription orders in the form originally prescribed by the Regulations of 1972 may, however, continue to be so used when ordering the supply of drugs and medicines under that Law.
