THE IMMIGRATION (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO.2) RULES 1986

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (2) of Section Three of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972, as varied by the Immigration (Guernsey)(Variation) Order 1982, hereby makes the following Rules:-

Amendment to Rules of 1983.

The Immigration (Guernsey) Rules 1983 (a) as amended (b) are hereby further amended by adding the following new paragraph immediately after Paragraph 2 of the said Rules:

"2A. Nothing in these Rules shall be construed as permitting a person (other than a person referred to in section 1 (5) of the Immigration Act 1971) to be granted entry clearance, leave to enter or remain or variation of leave as a spouse of another if he or she will be aged under 16 on the date of arrival in the Bailiwick or (as the case may be) on the date on which the leave to remain or variation of leave is granted."


These Rules may be cited as the Immigration (Guernsey)(Amendment No.2) Rules 1986.
