THE IMMIGRATION (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) RULES 1990

Made 1 November 1990

Laid before the States

Coming into Operation 2 November 1990

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (2) of Section Three of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972, as varied by the Immigration (Guernsey)(Variation) Order 1982, and the Criminal Justice Act 1982 (Guernsey) Order 1983, hereby makes the following Rules:-

1. AMENDMENT TO RULES OF 1983

The Immigration (Guernsey) Rules 1983(a) as amended (b), (c), (d), (e), (f) and (g) are hereby further amended by substituting the following Appendix for the Appendix of the said Rules:-

The Immigration (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules 1989 are repealed.

3. CITATION


These Rules may be cited as the Immigration (Guernsey)(Amendment) Rules 1990.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Rules amend the Immigration (Guernsey) Rules 1983 and require certain nationals of Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia to obtain visas for journeys to the Bailiwick of Guernsey. The new Appendix, in the interests of clarity, lists all the countries or territorial entities whose nationals require visas. Nationals of Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Argentina and the German Democratic Republic no longer require visas and those countries have been removed from the list.
