Public Vehicle (Amendment) Regulations, 2001

Made 20th November, 2001

Coming into force 1st January, 2002

The States of Alderney General Services Committee in pursuance of powers vested in it by section 11 of the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966, as amended, **HEREBY ORDER**:-

Amended to the Schedule

1. For the Schedule to the Public Vehicle Regulations, 1986, there is substituted the following:-
