The Electoral Roll (Specified Sum for Candidates' Copies) Regulations, 1999

THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 36 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^(a) as amended^(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Specified sum for candidates' copies of Electoral Roll

1. It is hereby specified that the sum which must be paid to Her Majesty's Greffier by a candidate at an election to procure additional copies of a section of the Electoral Roll is the sum of three and a half pence for each page in that section of the Electoral Roll.

Repeal

2. The Electoral Roll (Specified Sum for Candidates' Copies) Regulations, 1996^(c) are repealed.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Electoral Roll (Specified Sum for Candidates' Copies) Regulations, 1999.
