**The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2006**

Made 12th September 2006

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 14 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended^(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments

1. For the third schedule to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 2003^(b) substitute the provisions set out in the schedule to these regulations.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2006

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st day of September 2006.

These Regulations amend the definition and endorsement requirements for an additional fee to be paid for dispensing zero discount items as pharmaceutical benefit.
