**The Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment)  
Regulations, 1993**

**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 37 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. In Regulation 11 of the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978<sup>(b)</sup> add the following paragraph immediately after paragraph (3):

**"Young person deemed to have been a child**

(4) As regards a person deemed to have been a child in accordance with Section 37 (6) of the Law, he shall be treated as if he were, at death, the child of the family of any person

- (a) in whose family he was, or could have been, but for a failure to make a claim, or for a prior claim by another person, included when he ceased to be a child; or
- (b) a parent."

**Repeal**

2. Regulation 14 of the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 is repealed.

**Extent**

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993.

**Commencement**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1993.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations are consequential on the amendment of the Social Insurance Law to provide that a death grant may be payable on the insurance record of a parent, or person in a similar position to a parent, where the deceased is under the age of 23.
