The State of Emergency (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2001

WHEREAS it appears to the States Emergency Council that there have occurred or are about to occur events of such a nature as to be calculated, by interfering with the means of transport, to deprive the community within the Bailiwick of Guernsey or a substantial portion of that community, of the essentials of life

NOW THEREFORE THE STATES EMERGENCY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of the Emergency Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1965, by this order declares that a state of emergency exists.
