THE FISHING VESSELS (SAFETY PROVISIONS) (FEES) (GUERNSEY)
REGULATIONS 1990

Made 13th November 1990
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st December 1990

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Section 6 of the Fishing Vessels (Safety Provisions) Act 1970 (a), as extended to the Bailiwick by the Fishing Vessels (Safety Provisions) (Guernsey) Order 1990 (b), hereby orders:-

1. The fees payable in respect of services performed by a surveyor in accordance with Part V of the Fishing Vessels (Safety Provisions) Rules 1975 (c) shall be determined by the amount of work involved, charged at the following hourly rates:-


(a) For work undertaken Mondays to Fridays inclusive, except on Bank Holidays, between 8.0 a.m. and 6.0 p.m.	£35.25 per hour or part thereof.
(b) For work undertaken Mondays to Fridays inclusive, except on Bank Holidays, between 6.0 p.m. and 8.0 a.m. and all day Saturdays.	£45.35 per hour or part thereof.
(c) For work undertaken Sundays and Bank Holidays.	£60.45 per hour or part thereof.

2. The fee prescribed by regulation 1 shall be paid as follows -
 - (a) a fee of an amount calculated by reference to the surveyor's estimate of the work involved shall be paid to the surveyor by the owner of the vessel concerned when he is informed of the amount thereof; and
 - (b) the fee shall be recalculated on completion of the survey and any balance shall be paid to the surveyor by the owner or, as the case may be, refunded by the surveyor to the owner.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Fishing Vessels (Safety Provisions) (Fees) (Guernsey) Regulations 1990 and shall come into operation on 1 December 1990.
