THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sections 14 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments

1. (a) After paragraph 2(1)(d) of the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990^(b), insert

"(e) the products of the specified percentages in respect of that class of supplier and that description of pharmaceutical benefit in accordance with the Fourth Schedule to these Regulations and the amount of the basic price."

(b) After the Third Schedule to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990,^(b) insert the provisions set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.


Citation

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations,
but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations provide for two new fees to be paid in respect of those items where no discount to the basic price has been obtained provided they are contained in the "ZD List" in accordance with the Drug Tariff and the medical prescription has been endorsed "ZD" and expensive items of pharmaceutical benefit.
