

THE IMPORT DUTIES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (QUOTA RELIEF)
(PAPER AND PAPERBOARD) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1974.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section twenty one of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972 hereby orders:-

1. The Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Quota Relief) (Paper and Paperboard) Order, 1974 (a) is hereby amended as follows:-

the quantities of goods specified in the second column of the Schedule thereto are revoked and the following quantities are substituted therefor-

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Quota Relief) (Paper and Paperboard) (Amendment) Order, 1974.
(2) This Order shall come into operation on the eighteenth day of September, 1974.
