THE IMPORTATION OF FERTILISERS AND FEEDING STUFFS  
ORDER, 1991

Made .....20th August 1991

Coming into force .....21st August 1991

The States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952 as amended (a) and now vested in it (b), hereby orders:-

1. The importation into the Island of ruminant feeding stuffs which contain animal protein (except milk, milk products and dicalcium bone phosphate) is prohibited.
2. The importation into the Island of animal feeding stuffs, (including pet foods), which contain bovine offal is prohibited.
3. The importation into the Island of fertilisers which contain bovine offal is prohibited.
4. In articles 2 and 3 "bovine offal" means the brain, spinal cord, spleen, thymus, tonsils and intestines of a bovine animal which was over six months of age when slaughtered.
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (c) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
6. This Order may be cited the Importation of Fertilisers and Feeding Stuff Order, 1991.

7. This Order shall come into force on 14th August 1991.
8. The Importation of Feeding Stuffs Order, 1990 (d) is hereby repealed.
