The Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1979

Made the 20th day of November, 1979.

Coming into force on the 35d day of December, 1979.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963 (a), hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1968, as amended (b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) section six thereof is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor -

"6. A person, being in charge of a public vehicle, shall not park that vehicle in any disc parking place or approved parking place except when that vehicle is on hire to a passenger:

Provided that -

(a) in the case of a public vehicle in respect of which there is in force a taxi licence, such person may park that vehicle -

(i) in any of the approved parking places Nos. A4, A6, A7 or A49, for the purposes of standing or plying for hire;

(ii) on the west side of the area of the road comprised in approved parking place No A7 between the hours of midnight of any day and midnight of the day next following for any continuous period not greater than a period of one hour for purposes other than standing or plying for hire;

(iii) in any of the disc parking places specified in Part I of the First Schedule to this Order between the hours of six o'clock in the afternoon of any day and eight o'clock in the forenoon of the day next following for any continuous period not greater than a period of ten hours for purposes other than standing or plying for hire;

(b) in the case of a public vehicle in respect of which there is in force a private hire motor car licence, such person may park that vehicle -

- (i) in any of the disc parking places specified in paragraphs (a), (b) or (c) of section nine of this Order in accordance with the provisions of the said paragraphs (a), (b) or (c), as the case may be, regulating the parking of vehicles in any such disc parking place, notwithstanding that the vehicle is not on hire to a passenger;
 - (ii) in any of the disc parking places specified in Part I of the First Schedule to this Order between the hours of six o'clock in the afternoon of any day and eight o'clock in the forenoon of the day next following for any continuous period not greater than a period of ten hours, notwithstanding that the vehicle is not on hire to a passenger.";
- (b) immediately after paragraph (3) of section eight thereof there is inserted the following additional paragraph numbered "(4)" -
 - "(4) A person, being in charge of a vehicle, shall not without the permission in writing of the Chief Officer park that vehicle in approved parking places Nos. A52, A53 or A54 between the hours of eight o'clock in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon of any day except on any Sunday or Bank Holiday.";
- (c) in paragraph (a) of section nine thereof the word, letters and figures "Nos. D21 and D92" are repealed and the word, letter and figures "No. D21" are substituted therefor;
- (d) in paragraph (b) of section nine thereof immediately after the letter and figures "D87" there are inserted the letter and figures "D92";
- (e) in paragraph (c) of section nine thereof the word, letters and figures "Nos. D65, D66, D67, D68, D69, D70, D71, D72, D85, D88, D89 and D90" are repealed and the word, letters and figures "Nos. D66, D67, D68, D69, D70, D71, D72, D73, D85, D88, D89, D90 and D110" are substituted therefor;
- (f) in paragraph (d) of section nine thereof the word, letters and figures "D73, D75, D78, D91, D98, D99 and D100" are repealed and the word, letters and figures "D75, D78, D91, D98, D99, D100, D104 and D109" are substituted therefor;
- (g) in paragraph (e) of section nine thereof the letter and figures "D104" are repealed;
- (h) paragraph (f) of section nine thereof is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor -
 - "(f) in disc parking places Nos. D20 and D111 -
 - (i) during the hours in which the Public Markets are open for business save that -
 - (a) a person, being in charge of a motor delivery vehicle, may park that motor delivery vehicle in either of those disc parking places for any continuous period not greater than a period of thirty minutes between the hours beginning with the time at which the Public Markets are open

for business and ending at ten o'clock in the forenoon of any day;

(b) a person, being in charge of a vehicle, may park that vehicle in either of those disc parking places for any continuous period not greater than fifteen minutes between the hours beginning with the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon and ending with the time at which the Public Markets are closed for business;

(ii) during the hours in which the Public Markets are not open for business for any continuous period greater than a period of ten hours during the said hours.";

- (i) the entries relating to disc parking place No. D65 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto are repealed;
- (j) immediately after the entries relating to disc parking place No. D108 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto there are inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the First Schedule to this Order;
- (k) immediately after the entries relating to approved parking place No. A51 in each of the columns of Part II of the First Schedule thereto there are inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the Second Schedule to this Order;
- (l) immediately after the entries relating to approved parking place No. MB 17 in each of the columns of Part III of the First Schedule thereto there are inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the Third Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1979.

3. This Order shall come into force on the third day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Section one (j)

- "D109 Havelet,
Saint Peter Port. The north side of the road between a parking sign placed as near as may be to the premises known as the Hotel de Havelet and a parking sign placed as near as may be to the premises known as No. 10a Havelet.
- D110 New Road
Saint Sampson. The east side of the road between a parking sign placed as near as may be to the western corner of the Methodist Chapel and a parking sign placed as near as may be to the south-western gable end of the Methodist Chapel.
- D111 Fountain Street and
Market Street,
Saint Peter Port. The area of the road alongside the western corner of the Public Markets between parking signs placed as near as may be to each end thereof at the junction with Fountain Street and Market Street. "

SECOND SCHEDULE

Section one (k)

- "A52 Fountain Street,
Saint Peter Port. The north side of the road within the limits indicated by parking signs.
- A53 Market Square,
Saint Peter Port. The north side of the road within the limits indicated by parking signs.
- A54 The Quay,
Saint Peter Port. The west side of the road within the limits indicated by parking signs. "

THIRD SCHEDULE

Section one (l)

- "MB 18 Victoria Road,
Saint Peter Port. The south side of the road near its junction with Mount Hermon indicated by parking signs as being reserved for motor bicycles."
