GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1997 - No. 33

**The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit)
Regulations, 1997**

Made 5th November, 1997

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 5th January, 1998

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 27, 39, 50 and 116 of and Part II of the Fourth Schedule to the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^(a), hereby orders:-

Interpretation

1. (1) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment or regulations is (unless the context excludes) a reference thereto as amended, re-enacted, extended or applied.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^(b) applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Amendments

2. For the first and second schedules to the Social Insurance (Widow's Benefit and Old Age Pension) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^(c) substitute the schedules set out respectively in the first and second schedules to these Regulations.

3. In the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^(d) for the second, third and fifth schedules substitute the schedules set out respectively in the third, fourth and fifth schedules to these Regulations.

4. For the first and second schedules to the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^(e) substitute the schedules set out respectively in the sixth and seventh schedules to these Regulations.

5. For the second schedule to the Social Insurance (Industrial Injuries Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^(f) substitute the schedule set out in the eighth schedule to these Regulations.

6. In the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^(g) -

- (a) in Regulation 19(2)(a) for "£31.25" substitute "£32.25";
- (b) in Regulation 19(2)(b) for "£46.75" substitute "£48.25".

Transitional provisions relating to maternity grant

7. Where a woman has become entitled to a maternity grant (whether payment has been made or not) before the 5th January, 1998 and her confinement occurs or her pregnancy is otherwise terminated on or after that day, she shall be entitled to a maternity grant at the rate specified in Part III of the Schedule to the Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) Ordinance, 1997^(h).

Repeal

8. The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) Regulations, 1996⁽ⁱ⁾ are repealed.

Extent

9. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

10. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) Regulations, 1997.

Commencement

11. These Regulations shall come into force on 5th January, 1998.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations increase the reduced rates of widow's benefits, old age pension, unemployment benefit, sickness benefit, invalidity benefit and maternity allowance payable under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, in order to bring them into correspondence with the higher standard rates of such benefits approved by the States on 1st August 1997; increase the reduced amounts of death grant payable under that Law in order to bring them into correspondence with the higher standard amount of death grant approved by the States as aforesaid; and revise the rates of increase of industrial disablement benefit where constant attendance is required.

The remaining provisions of these Regulations effect minor consequential and other amendments.
