**The State of Emergency (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2001**

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of an order of the States Emergency Council made this day in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of the Emergency Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1965, a state of emergency has been declared to exist

NOW THEREFORE THE STATES EMERGENCY COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 2(1) of the Emergency Powers (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1965, hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Undertakings**

1. The States Advisory and Finance Committee is hereby authorised, after taking such advice as it sees fit, to give and honour undertakings on behalf of the States of Guernsey to indemnify or otherwise underwrite the liabilities of any organisation providing commercial services in the Bailiwick of Guernsey relating to air transport, in respect of third party war, terrorism and related risks, on such terms and conditions as the Committee may determine, for a period of up to 40 days commencing at 3.00 pm on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2001.
