**The Family Allowances (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2006**

**THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 7 of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Laws, 1950 - 84, as amended<sup>1</sup>, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. In regulation 8 of The Family Allowances(Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations 1977<sup>2</sup>, "Monday" is substituted for the word "Tuesday" in paragraphs (1), and (2) and "Sunday" is substituted for the word "Monday" in paragraphs (3) and (4).

**Interpretation.**

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 applies to the interpretation of these regulations throughout the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou<sup>3</sup>.

**Citation**

3. These regulations may be cited as The Family Allowances (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2006.

**Commencement**

4. These regulations shall come into force on 25th September, 2006.
