The Rabies (Amendment) Order, 1986

Made: 19th NOVEMBER 1986

Laid before the States:

Coming into Operation: 1st DECEMBER 1986

The States Committee for Agriculture, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 7 (2) of the Rabies (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 1975 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In the Rabies Order, 1976 (b), as amended (c) -

(a) for the title to section 9 substitute -

"Animals which have been outside Great Britain,
etc., within preceding 6 months";

(b) in section 9 (7) (a), after "any police force,"
insert "the States of Guernsey,"

Extent

2. This order has effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Sark, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

3. This Order may be cited as the Rabies (Amendment) Order, 1986.

Collective Title

4. This Order and the Rabies Orders 1976 and 1978 may be cited together as the Rabies Orders 1976 to 1986.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Order, which amends the Rabies Order 1976, as amended, is to permit dogs of the States Customs and Immigration Department to board vessels on which there are animals which have been in a place outside Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man during the preceding six calendar months.
