THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 14 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments

(b) For the Third Schedule to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990 substitute the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations.


2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1991.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990 by increasing certain of the amounts payable to authorised suppliers of pharmaceutical benefit from 1st September, 1991.
