The Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Restricted Substances) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 35 and 38 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Restricted Substances) Regulations, 1998, as amended ^(b) after the entry for esomeprazole (Nexium) add the row set out in the Schedule to these Regulations under the appropriate heading.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Restricted Substances) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 3rd day of October 2001.

SCHEDULE**Regulation 1**

Substance	Conditions under which the substance may be prescribed
"influenza vaccine	Ordered by a medical practitioner as part of a programme approved by the Authority. "

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations amend the previous Regulations so that there are restrictions on ordering influenza vaccine by medical practitioners so that they can only order it as part of an approved programme.
