The Protected Cell Companies (Fees for Insurers)  
(Amendment) Regulations, 1999

THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 57 and 63A of the Insurance Business (Guernsey) Law, 1986(a), hereby makes the following regulations:-

Increase in fees.

1. In the Protected Cell Companies (Fees for Insurers) Regulations, 1998(b)-

- (a) in regulation 2 for "£2,500" substitute "£2,800";
- (b) in regulation 3(a) and (b)(i) for "£1,950" substitute "£2,200".

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Protected Cell Companies (Fees for Insurers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999.
