**THE PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2003**

Made 5<sup>th</sup> December 2003  
Coming into force 12<sup>th</sup> December 2003

**THE STATES TRAFFIC COMMITTEE**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended<sup>1</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. In Part I of Schedule 2 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, the following entry is inserted immediately after the entry numbered "15"-

"15a. Collings Road Estate, West to East  
between the Oakvale School access road  
and Collings Road (i.e. the section  
known as Mahaut Gardens)"

**Citation.**

2. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 2003.

**Commencement.**

3. This Order shall come into force on 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2003.
