**The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical  
Benefit) (Amendment No. 4) Regulations, 2011**

**THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 as amended<sup>a</sup>, section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004<sup>b</sup> and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment.**

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004<sup>c</sup>, as amended add the rows set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations, under the appropriate headings.

**Interpretation.**

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>d</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

**Citation, commencement and extent.**

3. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment No.4) Regulations, 2011 and shall come into force on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of September 2011.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

8.1	Cytotoxic Drugs	Pazopanib tablets 200mg, 400mg (Consultant Medical Oncologist initiation only)
2.6.3	Other anti-anginal drugs	Ivabradine tablets 5mg, 7.5mg (Consultant Cardiologist initiation only)
