**THE PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2004**

Made 9<sup>th</sup> September 2004  
Coming into force 24<sup>th</sup> September 2004

**THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended<sup>1</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. In Part IX of Schedule 1 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, for the entry relating to paragraph 1, substitute the following entry:-

- "1. La Rue des Vatines and the section of La Rue des Cinq Vergers between its junction with La Rue des Vatines and its junction with La Vieille Rue except for access by vehicles having a laden weight not exceeding 3 tons to any premises therein.


**Citation.**

2. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 2004.
