GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1996 No 38

The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (First Prize Jackpot Draws) Order, 1996

Made: 18th December, 1996.  
Coming into operation: 30th January, 1997.

THE GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section 6 of The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinances, 1975 to 1994 (a), ("the Principal Ordinance"), hereby makes the following Order to prescribe the means by which, and the manner in which, draws known as "First Prize Jackpot Draws" shall be conducted:-

PROVISION OF FACILITIES FOR CONDUCT OF FIRST PRIZE JACKPOT DRAWS

1. For the purpose of conducting draws specified by the Committee as First Prize Jackpot draws, the Committee shall provide -
  - (a) two computer systems capable of random selection of the winning numbers, and the prizes in respect thereof;
  - (b) an apparatus consisting of a container capable of containing and agitating tokens and provided with a means by which tokens can be removed singly and at random;
  - (c) all such other equipment as may be necessary for the effective conduct of the draw and for the public announcement of the serial numbers of the winning tickets, and of the prizes drawn in respect thereof;
  - (d) a sufficient staff to assist the members of the Committee and the scrutineer officiating at the draw.

COMPUTER PROGRAMME

2. (1) The equipment to be provided in accordance with Section 1 of this Order shall include a lottery draw programme.

(a) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XX p. 51; No. XXVI of 1986; there are further amendments not relevant to this Order.

- (2) Such lottery draw programme shall be written -
- (a) so as to take account of whatever is specified under Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance; and
  - (b) so as to select at the draw by random selection from the serial numbers of all lottery tickets issued for sale by the Committee and the States of Jersey Gambling Control Committee, the winning numbers and all the prizes determined other than a Golden Jackpot Prize or a Silver Jackpot Prize.

DRAWING OF FIRST PRIZE JACKPOT

3. (1) The First Prize Jackpot, being either a Golden Jackpot Prize or a Silver Jackpot Prize, shall, if drawn, be awarded to the winner of the 1st (top) prize drawn in the first instance by the computer.
- (2) For the purpose of drawing a Jackpot Prize, the presiding officer shall introduce into the apparatus described in Section 1(b) of this Order -
- (a) one gold token denoting a Golden Jackpot Prize; and
  - (b) one or more silver tokens denoting a Silver Jackpot Prize; and
  - (c) one or more black tokens denoting no additional prize.

The number of silver and black tokens introduced shall be as determined from time to time by the Committee.

- (3) The drawing of a Golden Jackpot Prize, a Silver Jackpot Prize, or a token signifying no additional prize, shall be effected by the presiding officer causing -
- (a) the apparatus described in Section 1(b) of this Order to commence agitating the tokens contained therein for a period of not less than five seconds;
  - (b) after such period has elapsed, one token to be removed at random from the apparatus; and
  - (c) the colour of the token so drawn to be verified and recorded, the value of the prize to be determined and publicly announced.
- (4) The drawing of a particular token as described in Section 3(3) of this Order shall -
- (a) in the case of a black token being drawn, cause the 1st (top) prize drawn by the computer to remain unchanged and the sum of money allocated to the draw as a First Prize Jackpot to be carried forward to a subsequent draw by being placed in a fund known as a Jackpot;

- (b) in the case of a silver token being drawn, cause the 1st (top) prize drawn by the computer to be increased by the sum of money allocated to the draw as a First Prize Jackpot; and
- (c) in the case of a gold token being drawn, cause the 1st (top) prize drawn by the computer to be increased by the sum of money allocated to the draw as a First Prize Jackpot, together with any other monies which may have accumulated from previous draws in the Jackpot as described in Section 3(4)(a) of this Order.

The sum of money to be allocated to any one draw as a First Prize Jackpot shall be as determined from time to time by the Committee.

#### SCRUTINEER

- 4. In addition to the persons referred to in Section 6(4) of the Principal Ordinance, every draw shall be conducted in the presence of a scrutineer, who shall not be a member of the Committee or its staff.

#### MANUAL OF PROCEDURE

- 5. The presiding officer, the member of the Committee and the scrutineer shall conform to the procedure laid down in such manual of procedure relating to the testing and operation of the computer systems and the equipment referred to in Section 1 of this Order as shall be approved by the Committee.

#### RESULT OF DRAW

- 6. At the conclusion of the draw the list printed out by the computer of the serial numbers of the winning tickets and of the prizes drawn in respect thereof, together with the value of the Jackpot Prize, if such a prize is drawn and verified by those persons officiating at the draw, shall constitute the list referred to in Section 6(5)(e) of the Principal Ordinance.

#### SECURITY

- 7. Access to the computer systems, the equipment and the lottery draw programme referred to in Sections 1 and 2 of this Order shall be controlled in accordance with the procedures laid down in the manual of procedure referred to in Section 5 of this Order.

#### INTERPRETATION

- 8. In this Order -

"the 1st (top) prize" means the numbered prize drawn by the computer which is of the greatest value;

"First Prize Jackpot Draws" shall be draws determined by the Committee where the 1st (top) prize may be increased by the drawing of a gold or silver token in accordance with the procedure specified in Section 3 of this Order, in respect of which there shall be payable an additional prize as determined and specified by the Committee under Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance;

"tokens" means spheres which, regardless of whether gold, silver or black in colour, shall be identical in size and weight.

#### APPLICATION

9. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any draw unless the Committee, in accordance with Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance, shall so determine and so specify by notice published in La Gazette Officielle.

#### CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

10. (1) This Order may be cited as The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (First Prize Jackpot Draws) Order, 1996.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on the 30th day of January, 1997.
