The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1999

Made 17 November, 1999.
Laid before the States 1999.
Coming into Operation 1 January, 2000.

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15, 16, 18 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended^(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. The Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990 as amended^(b) are amended as follows:-

(a) In Regulation 4(6) for “three” substitute “five”.

(b) For the Third Schedule substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Repeal

2. The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1998^(c) are hereby repealed.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended, by increasing the charges payable to authorised appliance suppliers in Guernsey and Alderney by persons supplied with Part I, II or III medical appliances who are not exempt from such charges.

These Regulations also amend the previous Regulations to allow one original prescription and up to five copies to be issued at any time for Part I and Part II appliances. Previously only three copies could be issued.
