The Social Insurance (Married Women) (Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Regulations 1974.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section sixty-five and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to the principal regulations

1. Paragraph (2) of regulation 1A of the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(2) A married woman who has elected under the preceding paragraph not to be liable to pay a contribution under paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section two of the Law shall nevertheless in respect of each week for which a contribution as an employed person would otherwise be payable be liable to pay a contribution of six new pence: Provided that where a married woman has not attained the age of eighteen years, the weekly rate of contribution which she shall be liable to pay by virtue of this paragraph shall be two new pence."

Amendment to amending regulations of 1971

2. In paragraph (b) of regulation five of the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, for the reference to paragraph (b) of regulation eight of the principal regulations there shall be substituted a reference to paragraph (2) of the said regulation eight.

Citation, collective title and commencement

3.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1974.

(2) These regulations and the principal regulations, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1974.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the fourth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

Regulation one of these regulations further amends the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended, so as to provide for an increase in the reduced rate of contribution payable by a married woman who has elected not to pay the full rate of contribution payable by an employed person.
