The Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999

Coming into operation 1 January 2000

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 11, and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended ^(a), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In Regulation 3(6) of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 1990, as amended ^(b), for "three" substitute "five"

Citation

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 2000.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 1990, as amended, so as allow one original prescription and up to five copies of that prescription to be issued at any time. Previously only three copies could be issued.
