THE IMPORT DUTIES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)(NO. 80) Order, 1977

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section two of the Import Duties Act(Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended and in implementation of the obligations of the Bailiwick under the provisions of Protocol No. 3 annexed to the Treaty relating to the accession of the United Kingdom to the European Economic Community and to the European Atomic Energy Community hereby orders:-

1. The Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey)(No. 79) Order, 1977(a) is hereby revoked.
2. Where goods are required, for customs or other purposes, to be classified by reference to a tariff heading such classification shall be made within the headings of the common customs tariff of the European Communities and any such reference in a Guernsey enactment shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed accordingly.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
4. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey)(No. 80) Order, 1977.  
(2) This Order shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight.

THE IMPORT DUTIES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)(NO. 80) ORDER, 1977

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order, which comes into operation on 1 January 1978, revokes the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey)(No. 79) Order, 1977 which sets out the Bailiwick of Guernsey Customs Tariff.

The European Communities (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1973 provides that, with effect from 1 January, 1978, there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid on goods imported into the Bailiwick such Community customs duty, if any, as is for the time being applicable in accordance with the common customs tariff of the European Community, as amended from time to time. Such exemptions, reductions, suspensions or other derogations from the common customs tariff as are for the time being in force under the Treaties will also have effect in the Bailiwick.
