The Harbours (Cycling etc. Prohibition) Regulations, 2005

THE PUBLIC SERVICES DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 46(1) of the Harbours Ordinance, 1988^a, and all other powers enabling it, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Prohibition on skateboarding.

1. A person shall not ride, skate or slide on a bicycle, skateboard, rollers or wheels or any other similar contrivance or equipment upon the Liberation Monument.

Interpretation.

2. (2) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

“**the Liberation Monument**” means the monument, located on Saint Julian's Pier in the Harbour of Saint Peter Port, commemorating the liberation of Guernsey from enemy occupation during the Second World War including, for the avoidance of doubt, the stepped and raised paved areas of the monument,

and any other expression shall have the same meaning as in the Harbours Ordinance, 1988.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours (Cycling etc. Prohibition) Regulations, 2005.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 14th day of April, 2005.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prohibit cycling, skateboarding and roller-skating on the Liberation Monument. Under section 52 of the Harbours Ordinance, 1988 a fine of up to £200 may be imposed for contravention of the Regulations.
