THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 3(2) of the Immigration Act 1971(a), as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order, 1972, as amended(b), hereby makes the following rules:-

Amendment to Rules of 1983.

1. In the Immigration (Guernsey) Rules, 1983, as amended(c):-

(a) in Rule 11, for the words "specified in the Appendix" substitute "from time to time specified in the Appendix to the United Kingdom Statement of Immigration Rules";

(b) the Appendix is repealed.

Repeal.

2. The Immigration (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 1990 are repealed.

(b) United Kingdom S.I.'s 1972/1719; 1982/1834; and 1983/1897.

(c) Guernsey S.I.'s No 24 of 1983; No's 21, 31 and 37 of 1986; No 7 of 1987; No 25 of 1988; No 22 of 1989; and No 31 of 1990.

Citation.

3. These Rules may be cited as the Immigration (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 1992.

Commencement.

4. These Rules shall come into operation on the eighth day of April, 1992.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

These Rules amend the Immigration (Guernsey) Rules 1983 by repealing the Appendix and requiring the foreign nationals and Commonwealth citizens, stateless persons and other holders of non-national documents (collectively described as 'visa nationals'), from time to time specified in the Appendix to the United Kingdom Statement of Immigration Rules, to produce to the Immigration Officer a passport or other identity document endorsed with a United Kingdom visa.
