GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 1982 NO. 5

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) (GUERNSEY) ORDER 1982

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946 hereby orders:-

- 1. In the First Schedule to the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1978 (a) as amended, the entry relating to Wireless telegraphy apparatus shall be deleted and the following entry shall be inserted:-

"Wireless telegraphy apparatus consisting of radio telephonic apparatus capable of transmitting on any frequency between 26.1 and 29.7 megacycles per second or between 88 and 106 megacycles per second and notwithstanding that the said apparatus is also capable of transmitting on other frequencies outside the said limits, other than apparatus which is designed or adapted for the purpose of transmitting spoken messages, or other selective calling signals, or digital transmissions designed solely to identify the transmitter, on any of the frequencies specified in paragraph 1.3 of Home Office Performance Specification MPT 1320 and which complies in all respects with the requirements of that Specification."

- 2. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1981 (b) is hereby revoked.
- 3. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1982, and shall come into force on the seventeenth day of February, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Amendment Order is to permit the importation of certain wireless telegraphy apparatus consigned from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man without the authority of an Import Licence provided the apparatus (Citizen Band Radio) conforms to Home Office Performance Specification MPT 1320.
