The Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)(Guernsey)
Regulations, 1979

Made 22nd February, 1979
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 26th February, 1979

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (4) of section one of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders :-

Amendment of Part II of the First Schedule to the principal regulations

1. In Part II of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") there shall be inserted :-

(a) in column (A) thereof, the following paragraph -

" 7A. Employment under a contract of service which is subsidiary to other employment, not being employment under a contract of service, where the Authority is satisfied that -

(i) that contract of service was entered into with a view to

avoiding liability to pay Class 2
contributions; or

(ii) classification as an employed person
by virtue of that employment would
lead to inequalities or injustice to
the general body of insured persons
or of any class of insured persons. ";


(b) in column (B) thereof, the following paragraph -
" 7A. None."

Citation and Commencement

2.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance
(Classification)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1979, and these
regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as
the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978
to 1979.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the twenty-
sixth day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, so that employment under a contract of service may be treated as self-employment where the Authority is satisfied that the employment has been entered into with a view to avoiding Class 2 liability or where the classification as an employed person would lead to inequalities or injustice to the general body of insured persons or to any class of insured persons.
