**The External Companies (Exempted Companies)
Regulations, 1998**

Made	18th November, 1998.
Coming into operation	1st January, 1999.

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY POLICY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of The Companies (Alderney) Law (External Companies) Ordinance, 1998(a), hereby makes the following regulations:

Companies excluded from meaning of external companies"

1. For the purposes of The Companies (Alderney) Law (External Companies) Ordinance, 1998, the expression "**external company**" shall not include a body corporate of any of the following classes or descriptions-

- (a) a body corporate the memorandum and articles of which are registered in The Register of Companies within the meaning of section 117(1) of The Companies (Guernsey) Law, 1994(b);
- (b) a body corporate which is a company incorporated in Jersey under The Companies (Jersey) Laws, 1861 to 1968;
- (c) a body corporate which is a licensed institution within the meaning of section 56 of The Banking Supervision (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994(c);

(a) Ordinance No. IX of 1998

(b) Order in Council No. XXXIII of 1994; No. XIV of 1996

(c) Order in Council No. XIII of 1994.

- (d) a body corporate which is, and which is for the time being recognised by the Administrator of Income Tax as being, a charity within the meaning of section 40 of The Income Tax (Guernsey) Law, 1975(d);
- (e) the Corporation of the Trinity House of Deptford Strond in the County of Kent;
- (f) the Portsmouth Roman Catholic Diocesan Trustees;
- (g) the Salvation Army Trustee Company;
- (h) the Trustees for the Bailiwick of Guernsey Methodist Church Purposes.

Interpretation .

2. (1) In these Regulations expressions shall, except where the context excludes, have the same meanings as in The Companies (Alderney) Law (External Companies) Ordinance, 1998.

(2) The provisions of The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(e) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as they apply in Guernsey to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment or statutory instrument is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, replaced or re-enacted (in either case, with or without modification), extended or applied.
