

**The Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Restricted Substances)  
(Amendment) Regulations, 2003**

**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 35 and 38 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990<sup>(a)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Restricted Substances) Regulations, 1998, as amended<sup>(b)</sup> after the entry for escitalopram (Cipraxel) add the row set out in the Schedule to these Regulations under the appropriate heading.

**Citation**

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Restricted Substances) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003.

**Commencement**

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 21st day of February 2003.
