The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefits) Regulations, 1999

Made 2nd December, 1999

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 3rd January, 2000

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 50 and 116 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^a, hereby orders:-

Interpretation

1. (1) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment or regulations is (unless the context excludes) a reference thereto as amended, re-enacted, extended or applied.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Amendment

2. For the second schedule to the Social Insurance (Industrial Injuries Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^c substitute the first schedule to these Regulations.

3. In the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978^d -

- (a) in regulation 19(2)(a) for "£34.00" substitute "£35.00";
- (b) in regulation 19(2)(b) for "£50.75" substitute "£52.25".

Repeal

4. The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) Regulations, 1998^e are repealed.

Citation

5. These regulations may be cited as The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) Regulations, 1999.

Commencement

6. These regulations shall come into force on 3rd January, 2000.

"SECOND SCHEDULE

Regulation 7

Rates of increase of industrial disablement benefit under section 50 of the Law
where constant attendance is required

Description of case	Rate of increase
1. Where beneficiary is dependent to a substantial extent on constant attendance	£42.00
2. Where beneficiary is dependent to a substantial extent on constant attendance and where attendance required is greater by reason of exceptionally severe disablement	£63.00
3. Where beneficiary is entirely or almost entirely dependent on constant attendance	£84.00
