
Appointed day.

1. The appointed day for the purposes of the Market Street (Closure) (Guernsey) Law, 2002, shall be the 4th January, 2005.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Order)

This order appoints, for the purposes of the Market Street (Closure) (Guernsey) Law, 2002, the 4th January, 2005, as the day on which Market Street shall be closed and shall cease to be a public highway.

The relevant parts of Market Street within the meaning of the Market Street (Closure) (Guernsey) Law, 2002, means those parts of Market Street and Market Square in Saint Peter Port which are situated at or towards the eastern end of the Market Building and which are shown on the plan signed for the purposes of the Law by the Bailiff and lodged at the Greffe.
