THE MOTOR VEHICLES (INTERNATIONAL CIRCULATION) (DRIVING PERMIT FEE) ORDER, 2006

Coming into force

1 February 2007

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in accordance the powers conferred upon it by section 1(4) of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974, as amended⁽¹⁾, hereby orders:-

Prescribed fee.

1. For the purposes of section 1(4) of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974, as amended, the fee prescribed for the issue of a driving permit issued under section 1 (1) of that Ordinance shall be seven pounds.

Repeal.

2. The Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Driving Permit Fee) Order, 1999⁽²⁾ is hereby repealed.


Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Driving Permit Fee) Order, 2006.

Commencement.

4. This Order shall come into force on the first day of February, 2007.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order is made under of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Ordinance, 1974, as amended, and raises the fee for obtaining an International Driving Permit from £5 to £7.
