**The Driving Tests and Driving Licences (Increase of Fees) Regulations,  
2004**

**THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 2A(b) and 2B of the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987, as amended <sup>(1)</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendments to 1995 Ordinance**

1. The Driving Licences (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995, as amended <sup>(2)</sup>, is further amended as follows:-

(a) for Schedule 2 substitute the following Schedule -

*Driving test fees*

The fee payable prior to taking a test of competence relating to a motor vehicle of a class included in the category set out in column (1) of the Table below shall be the corresponding sum set out in column (2) thereof.

(b) where the subsisting or revoked licence is surrendered pursuant to section 9(1) or (2) of		

this Ordinance and the Committee is required to grant a new licence free of charge	£7.60
(5) A licence issued in exchange for a licence issued by the competent authority in a country outside the Island	£25.00
(6) The first licence granted to a person after the expiration of a period of disqualification imposed upon him by an order of the court where -	
(a) the licence will remain in force for less than six years	£15.00
(b) the licence will remain in force for more than six years, for each year or part thereof until its expiration	£2.50
(7) A licence granted pursuant to section 11(2) of the principal Law	£7.60
(8) A duplicate licence	£7.60".

**The Driving Tests and Driving Licences (Increase of Fees) Regulations, 2004**

**Explanatory Note**

These regulations set the fees that are chargeable for tests of competence to drive and driving licences with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2005, by increasing approximately by RPI the current fees that are set out in Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 respectively of the Driving Licences (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995, as amended.
