THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended ¹, hereby orders:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. In Part VII of Schedule 1² to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, for the entry relating to paragraph 1, substitute the following entry:-

"1. La Rue de la Varde. This Paragraph applies only to vehicles.

Citation.

2. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2004.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force on 4th January 2005.
