**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended<sup>a</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. For Part III of the First Schedule to the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended<sup>b</sup>, substitute the Schedule set out in these Regulations.

**Citation**

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2002.

**Commencement**

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2003.

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended, by allowing hip protectors to be prescribed as a medical appliance.
