The Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 2000

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE, in pursuance of powers vested in it by the States and by Section 2 of The Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966, have made the following regulations:—

1. The Traffic Regulation 1986, as amended, are further amended as follows:—

(1) delete regulations 7(2) and replace with the following:—

7.(2) A vehicle of 30cwt unladen weight or over shall not be driven, laden or unladen, in any part of Victoria Street or High Street except when such vehicle is bound for any destination in those streets or Queen Elizabeth II Street, to deliver or to pick up a load or part of a load, or when returning after delivery of a load in Ollivier Street or, when the driver of the vehicle is the holder of a provisional driving licence issued under the provisions of the Driving Licence (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995, as amended, is under instruction and/or undertaking a test of competence to drive under the provisions of the Driving Licence (Guernsey) Ordinance 1995, as amended.

(2) delete regulation 13(1) and replace with the following:—

13.(1) A motor vehicle shall not be driven

(a) on the public highways known as Victoria Street, High Street, or in Newtown Road between the junction with

Braye Road and the junction with Birdcage Row, in the town of St. Anne, at a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour, and

(b) on every other public highway at a speed in excess of 35 miles per hour.

(3) delete regulation 16 and replace with the following:—

16. A person in charge of a vehicle other than a taxi, an omnibus or a doctor's vehicle shall not park that vehicle or allow it to be remain parked in the designated bays, on the northern side of the public highway known as Les Rocquettes between 0900 and 1700 hours on any day other than a Sunday.

(4) In the Schedule to the Regulations, delete the entry relating to the High Street Disc Zone, and substitute the following:—

2. These regulations may be cited as The Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 2000.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 2000.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of these amendments are:

- (1) To allow drivers of vehicles of 30 cwts and over who are under instructions and taking their driving licence test of competence, to drive in Victoria Street, High Street and Queen Elizabeth II Street;
- (2) To set a speed limited of 15 mph in Victoria Street, High Street and part of Newtown Road.
- (3) To allow a doctor's vehicle to park in the restricted area at Les Rocquettes; and
- (4) To increase the Disc Parking Zone maximum parking period in High Street, to one hour and vary the restricted hours.
