**The Electronic Transactions (Exemptions)
(Alderney) Order, 2002**

Made	23rd April, 2002
Coming into force	23rd April, 2002
Laid before the States	22nd May, 2002

The States of Alderney Policy & Finance Committee in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 11 of the Electronic Transactions (Alderney) Law, 2001 (a) **hereby makes the following order**:-

Exempted matters

1. The provisions of sections 1 to 5 and 8 of the Electronic Transactions (Alderney) Law, 2001 shall not apply to:-
 - (a) the conveyance of real property or the transfer of any interest in real property including any contract prior thereto;
 - (b) leases of real property;
 - (c) the creation, execution, variation, rectification or revocation of a will, codicil or any other testamentary instrument;
 - (d) the creation, execution, variation, revocation or enforcement of an indenture, declaration of trust, power of attorney or any document required to be sealed;
 - (e) negotiable instruments;
 - (f) the making of an affidavit or a statutory or sworn declaration;
 - (g) warrants;

(h) any notice of:-

- (i) the cancellation or termination of utility services, including water, power and gas;
 - (ii) default, repossession, foreclosure or eviction in respect of real property;
 - (iii) the cancellation or termination of any insurance benefits; or
 - (iv) recall of a product, or material failure of a product, that risks endangering health or safety; and
- (i) the rules, practices and procedures of a court or tribunal, including pleadings, judgements and orders.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Citation

3. This Order may be cited as “The Electronic Transactions (Exemptions) (Alderney) Order, 2002”.

Commencement

4. This Order shall come into force on 23rd April 2002.

At least for the time being, the transactions and other matters specified in this Order must still be transacted and done without the benefit of making use of electronic means or electronic form.
