THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended¹, hereby orders:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. In Part I of Schedule 2 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, the following entry is inserted immediately after the entry numbered "86"-

"87. York Avenue, between Route Isabelle and South to North
De Beauvoir"


Citation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note does not form part of the Order)
