The Road Traffic (Clearway) (No. 2) Regulations, 1984

Made the 9th day of April, 1984.

Coming into operation on the 16th day of April, 1984.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a) and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island:-

Restrictions on waiting in Fountain Street

1.(1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this regulation, a person being in charge of an animal or a vehicle shall not, without the permission in writing of the Chief Officer, cause or permit that animal or vehicle to wait in any part of the carriageway of Fountain Street, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than to permit pedestrians to cross at the pedestrian crossing, between the hours of eight o'clock in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon on any day other than a Sunday or a Bank Holiday.

(2) The prohibition in paragraph (1) of this regulation shall not apply between the hours of eight o'clock and half past eight in the forenoon or between the hours of half past nine in the forenoon and six o'clock in the afternoon to any person causing or permitting a delivery vehicle to wait in a loading bay for no longer than is necessary in order to unload goods from and load goods into that vehicle.

Interpretation

2.(1) In these regulations -

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force;

"delivery vehicle" means a vehicle designed or constructed for use wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods;

"loading bay" means an area on which the Island Police Committee has marked the sign "UN/LOADING".

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these regulations to any other enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment.

Citation, commencement and duration

3.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Clearway) (No. 2) Regulations, 1984.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 9th April, 1984 and shall continue in force until the 9th October, 1984.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations)

These regulations impose, for a period of six months from 9th April, 1984, additional restrictions on waiting in Fountain Street, St Peter Port, which is already a clearway by virtue of the Road Traffic (Fountain Street) (Clearway) Ordinance, 1970.

The additional restrictions relate to delivery vehicles, which, except on Sundays and Bank Holidays, will not, while the regulations are in force, be permitted to wait at all in Fountain Street (except to allow pedestrians to cross at the pedestrian crossing) between 8.30 and 9.30 am; and at other times between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm will only be permitted to wait in a loading bay for no longer than necessary to load and unload.
