**The Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways
(Amendment) Regulations, 2007**

Made	10th July, 2007
Came into force	2nd August, 2007
Laid before the States	24th October, 2007

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 2 and 35 of the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966, as amended(a) and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby order:-

Amendment of regulations.

1. The Traffic Regulations 1986, as amended, (referred to hereinafter as "**the Regulations**") are further amended as follows –

- (a) immediately after regulation 2A insert a new regulation as follows –

"Temporary one-way streets and roads.

2.B The public highways listed in Schedule 3 shall henceforth be one-way for all vehicles travelling in the directions specified between the streets and roads noted in the Schedule for the trial period specified.",

- (b) in regulation 14 (disc parking zone), immediately after paragraph (4) insert the following paragraph –

"(5) In this Regulation references to the time indicated by the clock of a parking disc shall also be deemed to include a reference to the day, when setting a parking disc in the disc zone at Alderney Airport car park.",

- (c) in regulation 15(c), for "120 hours" substitute "23 hours",

(a) Ordinance Nos. 47; 119; 142; 154; 201; 204 and 241A

- (d) for Schedule 1 to the Regulations, substitute the following Schedule -

Victoria Street: between Les Rocquettes and Number 48 Victoria Street (presently used as a butcher's shop) on the north-west side and between Les Rocquettes and Number 3 Victoria Street (presently used as an Estate Agent) on the south-east side	0900 to 1230 hours and 1330 to 1700 hours on any weekday	One hour	Two hours
Le Huret: on its western side between Marais Square and the house known as Huret House (including the whole of the frontage of Huret House)	0900 to 1700 hours on any weekday	Thirty minutes	Two hours
Alderney Airport car park	Continuous	Twenty-three hours	One hour"

- (e) immediately after Schedule 2 to the Regulations, insert the following Schedule -

"Regulation 2B

Public Highways which are one-way for vehicles for a trial period

No	Name of street or road	Direction of one-way travel	Duration of trial period
1	High Street	From the junction at Victoria Street to the junction at Le Val	Two months from the date determined by Alderney General Services Committee".

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways (Amendment) Regulations, 2007.

Commencement.

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 2nd August, 2007.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways (Amendment) Regulations, 2007.

These Regulations amend the Traffic Regulations 1986 and have the following effect -

- (1) To remove the Disc Parking Zone on the northern side of the High Street between house numbers 5 to 8 (including the whole of the frontage of those houses).
- (2) To reduce the maximum parking period in the Alderney Airport Car Park to 23 hours, to create a parking disc zone at Alderney Airport Car Park and to provide for a parking disc to display the day as well as the time of arrival at the Alderney Airport Car Park.
- (3) To prescribe the public highways that are to be one-way for all vehicles travelling in the directions specified between the streets and roads noted in Schedule 3 to these regulations for a trial period as specified.
