

The Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1993

The States of Alderney Public Works Committee, in pursuance of powers vested in it by the States and by Section 2 of the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966, have made the following regulations:-

1. The Traffic Regulations, 1986, as amended, are further amended as follows:-

The Schedule to the Regulations is deleted and replaced with the following:-

| Victoria Street: between Les Rocquettes and Number 48 Victoria Street (presently used as a butcher's shop) on the north west side, and between Les Rocquettes and Number 3 Victoria Street (presently used by an Estate Agent) on the south east side | 0900 to 1230 hours and 1330 to 1700 hours on any weekday | One hour | Two hours |
| High Street: on its northern side, between the house known as Ivy House Number 8 High Street and the house known as Number 5 High Street (including the whole of the frontage of those houses) | 0900 to 1700 hours on any weekday | Thirty minutes | Two hours |
| Le Huret: on its western side, between Marais Square and the house known as Huret House (including the whole of the frontage of Huret House) | 0900 to 1700 hours on any weekday | Thirty minutes | Two hours |

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1993.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 26th day of July, 1993.
