THE IMMIGRATION (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) RULES 1987

Made 17th March 1987
Laid before the States
Coming into Operation 18th March 1987

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (2) of Section Three of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972, as varied by the Immigration (Guernsey) (Variation) Order 1982, and the Criminal Justice Act 1982 (Guernsey) Order 1983, hereby makes the following Rules:-

1. Amendment to Rules of 1983.

The Immigration (Guernsey) Rules 1983 (a) as amended (b), (c) and (d) are hereby further amended by the insertion of a reference to Nigeria after the reference to India, in the Appendix of the said Rules.

2. CITATION

These Rules may be cited as the Immigration (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules 1987.

3. COMMENCEMENT

These Rules shall come into force on the 18th day of March 1987.
