

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2006 No. 7

THE IMMIGRATION (WORK PERMIT FEE) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 2006

Made: 10 February 2006

Coming into force: 10 February 2006

THE STATES HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 33 (1) of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1993, hereby orders:-

1. The fee to be paid by an employer on an application for a work permit shall be:
 - a) where the Board is satisfied that the person to be named in it is to be employed for one month or less: £20;
 - b) in any other case: £150, or £50 for replacement of a work permit reported as lost or stolen.
2. The Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (Guernsey) Order, 1990 (a) is repealed.
3. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (Guernsey) Order, 2006.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 10 February 2006.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This order sets out various fees to be paid by an employer applying for a work permit in respect of an overseas national. The appropriate fee is to be paid on submitting the application. The order also sets of the fee to be paid in cases where a lost or stolen work permit is replaced.
