


THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT)

ORDER 1991

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law 1946 hereby orders:-

1. In Schedule 1 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1990 (a), the following entry shall be inserted after entry 12:-
 13. Any cosmetic product containing a substance set out in Schedule 1 to the Cosmetic Products (Safety) Regulations, 1989 (U.K. S.I. 1989/2233) as amended from time to time or in any re-enactment thereof.
2. In Schedule 2 to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1990 (a), the words "No entries" shall be deleted and the following entry shall be inserted:-
 1. Any cosmetic product containing a substance set out in Schedule 1 to the Cosmetic Products (Safety) Regulations, 1989 (U.K. S.I. 1989/2233) as amended from time to time or in any re-enactment thereof.
3. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order 1991, and shall come into force on the 10th April 1991.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to its general purport.)

The effect of the Amendment Order is to prohibit the importation from and the exportation to the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Isle of Man, of any cosmetic product containing a substance set out in Schedule 1 to the Cosmetic Products (Safety) Regulations 1989.
