The Seat Belts (Exemptions for Taxi Drivers) Order 1989

Made ... .. 20th February, 1989

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 13 of the Seat Belts Ordinance, 1988(a), hereby orders:-

Variation of  
Schedule 5.

1. In Schedule 5 to the Seat Belts Ordinance, 1988,  
(a), as amended (b) -

(a) immediately after sub-paragraph (k) of paragraph 1 there is inserted:

"(l) driving a vehicle in respect of which a taxi licence has been granted, whilst actually carrying a passenger for hire or reward.";

(b) immediately after the definition of "provisional driving licence" in paragraph 2 there is inserted:


" "taxi licence" means a public service vehicle licence granted in respect of a motor vehicle under section 7 of the Public Transport Ordinance, 1986(c) for the use of that vehicle to operate a taxi service, as defined in that Ordinance;"

(b) by Guernsey Statutory Instruments, 1989

- Incidental amendment to section 14(1)
2. In section 14(1) of the Seat Belts Ordinance, 1988, immediately after the definition of "specified passengers seat" there is inserted
- "taxi licence" has the meaning assigned by paragraph 2 of Schedule 5;"
- Citation
3. This order may be cited as the Seat Belts (Exemption for Taxi Drivers) Order 1989.
- Commencement
4. This Order shall come into force on 20th February, 1989.
